A message from our Provincial Minister, Sister Jo-Anne Grabowski


Peace and all good!

For 150 years, our Sisters have served and touched the lives of people in the continental United States and beyond, including Guam, Mexico, and Tanzania to name a few.

In 1874, women of courage, Mother Aloysia Lenders, and Sisters Veronica Conradi, Felicitas Dues, and Leonarda Hannappel crossed a threshold; they crossed a stormy sea to come to America, arriving in New York on June 5th, 1874. We celebrate them and the women who came after them.

At the end of June 2024, our Sisters and Associates from across the United States, our Sisters from Mexico, and members of our General Council will gather at Stella Niagara, New York to celebrate **“Crossing the Threshold - Then and Now!”** A few of the Ministers from our International Congregation will join us, too.

The Foundation Day of our Congregation was May 10, 1835. Little could Mother Magdalen Damen, our foundress, imagine that her small community would grow and expand beyond the borders of the Netherlands and Germany to far reaching lands. With her, we trust that “It is God’s work” and “God will provide,” as we cross thresholds, walking together into the future.

Funch*, do solemnly, sincerely and truly swear, that the following List or Manifest subscribed by me, and now delivered by me to the Collector of the Customs of the Collection District of New York, is a full and perfect list of all the passengers taken on board of the said vessel, has now arrived; and that on said list is truly designated the age, the sex, and the occupation of each of said passengers, the part of the vessel occupied by each during the passage, the country to which each belongs, and also the country of which it is intended by each to become an inhabitant; and that said List or Manifest truly sets forth the number of said passengers who have died on said voyage, and the names and ages of those who died.

Mother Aloysia Lenders, General Superior of the congregation, along with Sisters Felicitas Dues, Veronica Conradi and Leonarda Hannappel disembarked from the S.S.C.F. Funch to cast their net into the new world of America on June 5, 1874.

Like any classic story, this one has its twists and moments of suspense. The young Sisters made their way to Buffalo, New York at the invitation of Father Behrens, Superior of the German Jesuit Mission in America who asked for their help at Buffalo's growing German parishes. However, miscommunication and a breach of protocol resulted in this plan being rebuffed by the Bishop of Buffalo. What would they do?

Mother Aloysia informed her council of the setback and she was instructed to return to Germany. However, Sister Leonarda had become seriously ill and the sisters sought treatment in Cincinnati, Ohio with the Sisters of the Poor of St. Francis. While there, they were soon welcomed by Bishop Rosecrans of the Diocese of Columbus, Ohio, who asked for their assistance at an orphanage in Columbus.

Meanwhile, in yet another twist of fate, the Jesuit fathers in Buffalo had cleared the earlier obstacles and asked the sisters to return to teach in the parishes of St. Ann and St. Michael in Buffalo. How could they be in three places at one time?

Knowing they would need more sisters to help, and wanting to inform her council that all obstacles had been cleared, Mother Aloysius arranged to send a telegram. It read, "Send Sisters. Bishop Willing." The Councilors read the cable as a directive sent by "Bishop Willing," and quickly acquiesced to his instruction! This comedy of errors cemented the work and service of the Sisters of St. Francis of Penance and Christian Charity in the United States.

Having overcome those initial challenges, the sisters continued to be open to the risks that lay ahead. What would they encounter in this new world?

Their first convent on American soil, St. Joseph Convent, was a small house on Ellicott Street in Buffalo. *“Their first winter in Buffalo was not kind to them, either. It was unusually severe, and the cold winds that blew across Lake Erie found their way through every crack and crevice...Ice was frequently visible on the walls of the attic where the sisters slept, and often blankets of snow had to be shaken from the coverlets before the sisters arose.”* The Franciscan Sisters had no need to find ways to practice poverty. Poverty found them!

Undeterred, other women chose to join them, and by December 1874, their numbers were great enough to accept the invitation from Bishop Rosecrans to staff the new St. Vincent Orphanage in Columbus, Ohio. Soon after, the Sisters were asked to teach at Sacred Heart School in Columbus, where their presence continued until the school closed its doors in 1973. Many sisters dedicated most of their life to the school and its students: Sister Callista taught there for 47 years and Sister Rose Hardy, assigned in 1877 as a young professed sister, remained for 46 years.

The time had come for Mother Aloysia to return to Europe. From afar, she used the years from 1874 to 1876 to strengthen the American Mission by sending 46 additional sisters to join the fledgling mission.

Looking back, one is inspired by the staying power of these ministries. St. Vincent Orphanage grew and adapted to meet the needs of the community. Although the Sisters of St. Francis are no longer involved, this ministry continues today as St. Vincent Family Services, providing trauma-informed pediatric behavioral health care within a learning community to change the lives of children and families.

St. Vincent became the Ohio nucleus from which the sisters expanded their ministries in the state -- teaching in elementary and secondary schools, establishing St. Ann “infant asylum” (eventually becoming St. Ann’s Hospital for Women) and founding a boarding school, St. Aloysius Academy, in New Lexington. But what of those initial seeds in Buffalo?

Without a doubt, the growth of ministries in Western New York was astounding: St. Ann School in Buffalo had grown from 600 students in 1874 to over 2,100 in the latter 1880’s; St. Michael School leveled at 600 students.

And what of the first little American Convent on Ellicott Street? It had certainly served its purpose and a new building on Washington Street was dedicated to the Sacred Heart on April 6, 1878.





By the end of the 1800s there were 164 professed sisters, 29 novices and 14 postulants in the American Mission. The Sisters were ready when unknown territory beckoned once again.

In early 1886, three Sisters answered the call for volunteers to work among the Sioux Indian tribes at St. Francis Mission on the Rosebud Reservation. Arriving in the Dakotas in early spring, all that was visible was frozen grass-- not a tree, nor a cabin in sight. Far on the horizon was a tiny protrusion which turned out to be the mission site: one room in which the sisters were to live, eat and sleep. As in the past, they had no need to find ways to practice poverty. Poverty found them!

In 1892, Sister Cecilia Steffen was appointed to serve as the first Mission Superior and she continued the growth of the American mission. In 1901 five sisters, accompanied by Sister Leonarda, boarded the train in Buffalo and made their first cross-country journey to Sacramento, California to begin teaching at St. Francis School where they found a warmer welcome... descending into the verdant valleys of California with its palm trees, vineyards, fruits and flowers! Now established in New York, Ohio, the Dakotas and California, from where will the next call come?

Mother Cecilia's last commitment was made to staff Sacred Heart School in Charleston, West Virginia. The Sisters received a warm welcome on August 29, 1903 and recorded an opening registration of 65 students - impressive considering the Catholic population of the capital city was around 300! By its second year, the Sisters' reputation for excellence in education attracted Catholics and non-Catholics, expanding its student roster to 122 pupils. Mother Cecilia died, March 21, 1904, happy in the knowledge that the seeds planted by Mother Aloisia Lenders and her companions had grown strong and multiplied.

This wraps up the first chapter of the Sisters' legacy in the United States. Their story, too great to condense into these few pages, will continue in our autumn newsletter, where we'll learn how a visit from the Provincial Superior of Germany and the North American Mission, Mother Seraphine, changed the perspective on the placement of the new American novitiate and motherhouse.

On June 13, 1904, Sister Leonarda Hannappel became the second superior of the North American Mission.



Mission Moments

In the spirit of ecological conversion, we commit ourselves to the sustainability of our planet especially at this time of climate crisis. (General Chapter recommendation - Sisters of St. Francis of Penance and Christian Charity)

Climate change is a vital part of the curriculum at both The Buffalo Academy of the Sacred Heart (SHA) and Stella Niagara Education Park (SNEP), two of our sponsored schools. Sister Mara Walton, who has taught and served on the respective boards of both schools, says her role has given her the opportunity to see the importance of this topic within the classroom as well as in extracurricular activities. In her experience, students see climate change as a cyclic event where one action can easily impact another and that each action has its importance. Teachers at both schools continue to be an inspiration as they make environmental issues an important everyday topic.

SNEP began its Outdoor Education program in 2015 and under the direction of a coordinator and the classroom teachers, each student from Montessori 3-year-olds to 8th graders has an outdoor experience each day -- rain, snow or sun! Special projects, such as a study of the Great Lakes Watershed, can all be explored on the campus' 100+ acres. Of particular note are the vernal pools that appear each spring. These temporary wetlands source their water from precipitation (rain and snow melt) and storm water runoff, but they are more than just puddles. They are evidence of our geologic history, and are valuable ecosystems that play a critical role in the life cycles of some of our most vulnerable wildlife today, including the spotted salamander, wood frog and spring peeper.



At SHA, extended study of environmental issues is a part of the International Baccalaureate Program. Each year students travel to countries such as El Salvador to work with the people to build latrines, fix fences, work in health clinics and teach religion. This gives the students a short but real experience of living "without" so many things they take for granted. A graduate of SHA is now serving with the Young Life program in El Salvador.

Sister Mara stresses that meeting former students who are now working in the field to combat various issues related to climate change has changed her own life knowing they are living out our shared Franciscan values.

Several years ago, Sister Christina Pecoraro came upon a family who were looking for "the little white house." They were referencing the little chapel at the river, now part of the Stella Niagara Preserve.

Almost two decades earlier Sisters Karen Allen and Carolyn Fisher had conceived of *Stella Niagara as Earth Center* -- envisioning possibilities for the grounds of Stella Niagara to serve as an ecological haven. They could have never guessed that at the meadow, a portion of their dream would be taken even further than they imagined. Nor did they foresee that all of this would occur as Pope Francis issued *Laudato Si', Care for our Common Home*.

There, a family found moments of refuge at the Stella Niagara Preserve. Beneath their feet were footsteps of our sisters dating back to 1907. Even earlier were the footprints of soldiers who fought there during the war of 1812. Still earlier were the imprints of the indigenous Native Americans.

A Native American from the West had once said we should "love this earth as the newborn loves its mother's heartbeat." Nature who loves the earth in just that way, welcomes saint and sinner alike. As she reveals the face of God, she seeks to heal, to delight, to nourish and to invite our praise.

On that day, as in the days to come, Nature did what she loves to do:

She opened the Doors of her Mercy.

Clínica Familiar Lak Ña Clara SNAP SHOT OF A MEDICAL MISSION

We've all heard the phrase "it takes a village;" well, in the case of our medical mission, it takes a village and then some!

Things have certainly changed from the days when our small team would load supplies into a pick-up truck in the early morning hours and set out across rough roads to remote villages. Today, roads and transportation have improved and the establishment of our permanent clinic has made a dramatic difference in delivering health care to the indigenous population.

Despite these improvements, help is still needed and in November 2023, a team of volunteers from Western New York and central California set out to make a difference. There were 5 physicians, 3 nurses, a nurse practitioner, a midwife, 3 interpreters, and a maintenance worker. They worked alongside seven of our sisters and the permanent clinic staff comprised of 3 physicians, a psychologist, social worker, clinic director, lab technician, nurse, x-ray technician, dentist, permaculture farmer, and maintenance worker. Also stepping in to help were 6 nurses and 1 physician who volunteered from the local city of Palenque. This cooperative effort enabled them to provide care to 585 patients in just 5 days!

The services provided varied from family practice and dental services, to lab services including sonograms and x-rays, ob/gyn examinations and education, nutritional and psychological counseling, as well as pediatric care.

Dr. Peter Kowalski, our team leader from Western New York, notes that having lab services on site has made a tremendous difference to deliver appropriate care. Additionally, being able to collaborate with local clinicians and communicate with specialists back home, has enhanced services and educational opportunities for patients and providers alike.

Everyone can help. Cash donations assist with the mission's most urgent needs. Donations of supplies help us provide items not easily obtained in the region, such as: AA or AAA batteries, Contour Next diabetes meters, testing strips and lancets, Small pill baggies, Large bottles (500 pills or more) of children's vitamins, adult vitamins and prenatal vitamins (*please note: no gummies, which can be mistaken for candy*), powdered Pedialyte, and various strengths of reading glasses.

Volunteers pay their own travel expenses, but room and board is provided on the mission property. We welcome family physicians and specialists, nurse practitioners, nurses, and English/Spanish translators to contact Sister Nancy Zelma to learn more.
